# Fringe

Fringe events are the most effective way to convey a message to our conference delegates by engaging in debate and discussion. You choose the topic to be discussed, invite the speakers either from within the SNP or externally and host the event.

Fringe meetings will take place during the lunch break from 12:30 - 13:30 and after the afternoon session of conference from 16:15 - 17:15.

## Each Fringe event includes:

- One hour scheduled event.
- Access to your room 30 minutes before and after your event.
- Five complimentary passes to attend conference for invited panel members and staff.
- A comprehensive listing in the conference handbook featuring your logo, a brief description, and a list of speakers.
- A room set up theatre style with a top table, projector and screen.

Hosts are also welcome to provide catering for their event to help attract more attendees. Catering should be booked separately and is not included in this package. Options will be sent to you once your booking has been processed.

A PA/AV package is included with all large room bookings.

Fringe rooms are set up theatre style, and events run for one hour as standard. Other room layouts and longer time slots may be possible on request. An additional fee will be applied for any changes due to the staffing and storage implications.

# Booking

## PAYMENT

All stated rates are exclusive of VAT. All invoices must be paid in full prior to the conference. Engagements which have not been settled will be removed from the event.

## CANCELLATION OF BOOKINGS

A cancellation fee of 75 per cent will apply from 31 – 60 days prior to the event. A cancellation fee of 100 per cent applies for cancellations from 30 days prior to the event.

## ELECTORAL COMMISSION GUIDANCE

The Political Parties, Elections and Referendum Act 2000 regulates all aspects of political finance, including donations to and sponsorship of political parties and their events. This includes the requirement that donations and sponsorships of over £11,180 are reported to the Electoral Commission. This may be a single donation or multiple donations over £500 from the same donor that add up to over £11,180 in a calendar year. Subsequent donations from the same donor for the rest of the calendar year over £2,230 must also be reported.
